About Heidi

Heidi Lau (b.1987) grew up in Macau and currently works in Brooklyn. She has been featured in exhibitions nationally and internationally in venues such as the Bronx Museum, Macao Museum of Art, Museum of Chinese in America (New York, NY), Wave Hill (Bronx, NY), Kniznick Gallery at Brandeis University and Real Art Ways (Hartford, CT). She has received numerous residencies and awards, including the Joan Mitchell Foundation Painters and Sculptors Grant, Emerging Artist Fellowship at Socrates Sculpture Park, Center for Book Arts Workspace Residency, Lower Manhattan Cultural Council Process Space and BRIC Media Arts Fellowship, among others. She completed the Bronx Museum's Artist in the Marketplace (AIM) program in 2011 and was an artist in residence at the Museum of Art and Design Artist Studios in 2017.

Geary was founded in the Lower East Side in 2013 by Jack Geary and Dolly Bross Geary, and then moved to its current location on Varick Street in West Soho. The gallery represents twelve emerging and mid-career artists working in a variety of media, with an emphasis on those from New York City and the Midwest. Geary presents solo, two-person, and group exhibitions, and seeks to raise artist profiles and exposure through art fairs, including EXPO Chicago, the Dallas Art Fair, and NADA New York and Miami Beach.
